



To sign in to your account, look for a link or button in the top right corner of the website.



Miguel can click on the link "Forgot Password" to see what his choices are.



1.5 Reset Email




Notes:

To reset your password by email, you must be able to access to the email address associated with your account. [pause]


When you select this option, an email message will be sent to that email address. [pause] Miguel logs into his email to find a new message.

The message usually contains a link or a code to reset your password. [pause] Follow the instructions in the email message to choose a new password.


